Establishment of Quorum:

Commissioner Pagats called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. and announced there was a quorum. Commissioners 3C01, 3C02, 3C03, 3C04, 3C06, 3C07, 3C08 present. SMD 3C05 absent.

Verification of Notice:

Commissioner Pagats confirmed that notice of the meeting was sent to the local community listservs, apartment listserv moderators, and posted on the ANC3C website, and sent out via the ANC3C Newsletter.

Approval of Agenda:

Commissioner Pagats moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Kripke (3C07) moved to add a letter in support of PKEEP. Commissioner Prinzo (3C02) raised that the item may be added to the Commission Business section of the agenda. The motion was seconded and approved by unanimous voice vote. - Public Safety Committee presented by Commissioners Nash and Prinzo: Playground safety at the Macomb park mentioned by Commissioner Prinzo. Commissioner Nash includes pedestrian and road safety as a part of the public safety framework.
- Virtual, Hybrid, and In-Person Meeting Task Force presented by Commissioner Bose: Meeting in May to organize an in-person ANC3C monthly meeting. Commissioner Pagats raises points of inquiry regarding tech requirements.

3. Mayor, Council, Agency, Community Organizations:

1. MOCR Report: Kendall Gibson reports on community engagement efforts and is hosting monthly office hours at Palisades Library from 2-5 PM on April 25th. Gibson informed the commission of Mayor Bowser's out-of-school initiative called MOST, shared a bulk trash removal event near the campus of American University.
2. Councilmember Frumin's Office: Workday in the Ward will be hosted at the Palisades Farmers Market on Sunday, April 27th. Trisha Kondabala informed the commission of Councilmember Matt Frumin's recent public engagement opportunities. Commissioner Bose (3C06) shared his appreciation.
3. Commissioner Pagats (3C03) reported on upcoming Cleveland Park Main Street events on behalf of Cassandra Hetherington.
4. Commissioner Prinzo (3C02) reported on recent administrative changes of Woodley Park Main Street.

Community Forum:

- Lily Minkove offers an overview of PKEEP and requests support for program funding.
- Todd Cain shared lobbying resources for DC residents to engage with Congress.

Commission Business:

- Commissioner Kripke provides the Treasurer's Report: Commission is in good standing with nothing to report.
- Discussion and vote on ~\$3k direct expenditure to a vendor to support sound & stage for Cleveland Park Day (June 8th) via Cleveland Park Main Streets. Motion is approved by unanimous vote.
- Discussion on the funding of PKEEP. Resolution submitted in the meeting chat by Commissioner Kripke (3C07). The motion is seconded.
 - Commissioner Littauer (3C01) raises a point of inquiry around the process of moving to table discussion until the next meeting.
 - Commissioner Prinzo (3C02) moves to table this discussion until the next meeting of the Commission. Commissioner Littauer seconds.
 - Commissioner Pagats calls the motion to a vote. The motion to table the resolution passes by 6-1-0, Commissioner Kripke (3C07) dissenting.

Other Business:

Commissioner Prinzo moved to adjourn the meeting, citing support of the Washington Capitals in Game 2 of the Stanley Cup Playoff's East 1st Round against the Montreal Canadiens. Commissioners unanimously second, and approve by voice vote and the meeting adjourned at 7:43 pm.
