ANC 3C Resolution 2025-003
Approving a Community Grant to the Hardy Middle School PTO for Math Intervention

WHEREAS, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C (“ANC3C”) represents the residents of Woodley Park, Cleveland Park, Massachusetts Avenue Heights, and Woodland-Normanstone in Ward 3; and

WHEREAS, Hardy Middle School is the by-right DCPS neighborhood middle school that serves graduates of Eaton Elementary School, located in ANC3C, and therefore serves a significant number of children and families who live within ANC3C’s boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Hardy MS PTO has submitted a grant request seeking \$2,405.56 to purchase and implement Math 180, an evidence-based intervention curriculum designed to improve foundational math skills for struggling learners; and

WHEREAS, DCPS does not fund specialized math intervention curricula of this kind, and therefore this proposal does not duplicate a District government service, but instead fills a community instructional gap; and

WHEREAS, ANC expenditures must serve a public purpose that benefits persons who live or work in the Commission area, and the Commission finds that improved instructional support for resident middle-school students constitutes a meaningful and direct public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Hardy MS PTO has confirmed that no overhead costs are associated with the grant, and will comply with all statutory reporting, documentation, post-award accounting, and expenditure requirements.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC3C APPROVES and ENDORSES the Hardy Middle School PTO grant request in the amount of \$2,405.56; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that ANC3C authorizes its Chair and Treasurer to execute the grant agreement and payment, and authorizes the Commissioner for 3C07 and the Chair to monitor grant reporting, compliance, and documentation consistent with DC law and OANC requirements.
