RE: Requesting DDOT Install *No Turn on Red Signs* at Various Intersection Throughout ANC3C

Director Kershbaum,

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting on March 17, 2025 with a quorum present, a quorum being five commissioners, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C (ANC 3C) voted 8-0-0 to submit this request that expanded safety measures throughout ANC3C through the installation of No Turn on Red Signs.

As you are aware, overall road safety remains a top priority for our community, and limiting right turns on red is a proven measure to reduce conflicts between vehicles and other vulnerable road users. Based on community feedback, we believe the following intersections would benefit from No Turn on Red restrictions:

1. Connecticut Avenue, NW & Cathedral Avenue, NW
2. Connecticut Avenue, NW & Calvert Street, NW
3. Connecticut Avenue, NW & Devonshire Place, NW
4. Wisconsin Avenue, NW & Woodley Road, NW
5. 34th Street, NW & Cleveland Avenue, NW
6. Porter Street, NW & 34th Street, NW

We believe these NTOR restrictions will help further that goal by reducing the risk of crashes and enhancing pedestrian safety at street crossings.

The Commission authorizes the Chair, the Commissioners for 3C02 and 3C04 and/or their approved designee(s) to represent the Commission on this matter.
