Dear Director Brown and Ms. Toruellas,

We are writing, as ANC members of the ANC3C, to provide our comments on the 2014 DC Circulator Transit Plan.

ANC 3C passed Resolution 2010-035 supporting extension of the Circulator to our community on September 20th, 2010, namely, to extend service to the National Cathedral and the National Zoo, both major cultural destinations in our City. You will find attached a copy of the Resolution and Cover Letter.

We strongly support the extension of the Wisconsin Ave. Circulator bus route north to the National Cathedral, a densely populated neighborhood with no Metro access. The extension of the Circulator is consistent with the recently announced DDOT moveDC action plan (which calls for high frequency bus service along the Wisconsin Ave. corridor), and will resolve many current concerns about bus service by providing new frequent and predictable service to our residents.

In addition, ANC 3C would appreciate being involved in the development of the specific route since it could involve using residential streets to transition from north bound to south bound travel. We believe it is important to allow local resident feedback during the planning stage of the route extension.

We thank you for the planned extension of the Circulator and for your consideration of our ANC3C Resolution 2010-035.
