ANC3C RESOLUTION NO. 2008-005
Resolution Regarding Support for Approval of Tax-Exempt Financing for
National Child Research Center Construction

WHEREAS the National Child Research Center, (“NCRC”), a preschool located in ANC3C has applied to the District of Columbia government for authority to issue revenue bonds through the District of Columbia revenue bond program, the interest on which will not be taxable to the bond holder; and

WHEREAS such bonds are secured solely by the borrower, NCRC, and are not obligations of the DC government; and

WHEREAS NCRC proposes to use the proceeds of such bonds to finance construction and renovation of its facilities at 3209 Highland Place, NW; and

WHEREAS such construction and renovation are pursuant to and consistent with an agreement reached between NCRC and the Cleveland Park Neighbors, an organization that represents the neighbors surrounding NCRC on Highland Place, Newark and Ordway Streets; and

WHEREAS NCRC and the immediate adjacent neighbors have reached a construction management agreement regulating such construction for the neighborhood’s benefit:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ANC3C supports NCRC’s application for tax-exempt financing and recommends that its application be granted by the District of Columbia government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair or her designee is authorized to represent the Commission in this matter.
