ANC 3C Resolution 2012-009

Regarding an HPRB Application for a Parking Structure
Behind the Cleveland Park Firehouse (Engine 28)

WHEREAS the DC Fire and Emergency Management Services (FEMS) has an application for concept approval pending before the Historic Preservation Review Board (HPRB) regarding parking for the Engine 28 fire station on Connecticut Avenue, NW, a contributing property within the Cleveland Park Historic District; and

WHEREAS it is generally inappropriate to change an historic structure unless it is being returned to its original architecture or renovated to be consistent with the rhythm and character of the historic district where current conditions cannot be confirmed as historic but conflict with the rhythm and character of the historic district; and

WHEREAS the fire station lacks adequate parking for the firefighters stationed there; and

WHEREAS the application proposes to build a parking deck behind the firehouse; and

WHEREAS the open rear yard of the station is accessed from a driveway at Connecticut Avenue, and air space about one story above the grade of the station's ground floor could be accessed from a public alley; and

WHEREAS an open deck platform could be installed in the air space without compromising parking on the ground level; and

WHEREAS a structural deck could be constructed to support automobiles of the fire fighters, which could greatly reduce or resolve the lack of parking for the fire fighters; and

WHEREAS such a structure would not be visible from Connecticut Avenue and would not appear to adversely impact the contributing elements of this building to the historic district of which it is a part; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ANC3C supports this application; and
