## ANC 3C Resolution 2013-023

### Regarding Modernizing the Payment of the ANC Allotment

WHEREAS, DC law does not allow for any electronic payments or payment by method other than paper check signed by two officers of the ANC, and

WHEREAS, ANC3C has, during this fiscal year, either not received or received many months late, two of its three allotments from the DC government, and the Office of the ANCs has reported that other ANCS have confronted the same issue, and

WHEREAS there have been major advances in computer payment security.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3C urges the DC Government (the appropriate agencies under the Mayor, and under direct oversight by the City Council) to consider modernizing the payment of the ANC allotments to the ANCs from its current paper check system mailed to the bank to a more modern electronic funds transfer or web based payment system; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ANC3C further urges the DC Council to modernize the ANC legislation with the view to allow the ANCs the discretion of paying its payees using more modern payment systems, such as, but not limited to, electronic funds transfer and other payment systems, which are deemed particularly useful to pay recurring expenses such as rent; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of ANC 3C bring this resolution to the Mayor's quarterly meeting with ANC chairs, and that copies of this resolution are sent to the City Council for their consideration, and

BE IT RESOLVED that ANC3C seeks the opinion and support of its fellow ANCs regarding this matter, with the view of coordinating joint action regarding this matter.

Finally, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chair and/or the Treasurer of ANC3C are authorized to represent the Commission on this matter.
