ANC 3C Resolution 2013-040

Regarding the Cleveland Park Connecticut Avenue Improvement Project: Intersection of Porter St NW and Quebec St NW

Whereas, in 2010, ANC3C adopted a resolution regarding the Cleveland Park Connecticut Avenue Improvement Project, and

Whereas, a number of the recommendations in the resolution have been implemented, as a result of DDOT and the community working together to improve traffic and aesthetic conditions, and

Whereas, DDOT has followed up on ANC3C's recommendation that the intersection of Porter Street NW, Quebec Street NW and Connecticut Avenue NW be studied to resolve the significant pedestrian safety issues, and

Whereas it was also recommended that DDOT work with the owner of the Exxon station at the southeast corner of Connecticut Avenue and Porter Street to limit the number of driveways accessing the station, and

Whereas, it was recommended that DDOT work with appropriate agencies to minimize conflict with pedestrians at bus stop locations on Porter Street.

Therefore Be It Resolved that ANC 3C recognizes DDOT's time and attention in studying the affected intersection and its recommendations that improve the safety and aesthetics of the intersection, including elimination of the slip lane and introduction of green space, as well as restriping the intersection to improve pedestrian safety, and

Be It Further Resolved that ANC 3C urges DDOT to work with the gas station owner to close the northern exit from the station onto Connecticut Avenue, and

Be It Further Resolved that the Chair and Commissioners of SMD 3C04, 3C05, and 3C09 be authorized to represent the Commission on this matter.
