ANC 3C Resolution 2014-022

Regarding Petition Requesting the City to Consider Reconstructing Specific Alleyways
with Permeable Pavers

Whereas the "City Block" bordered by 3800-3828 Klinge Place NW, 3706-3718 Massachusetts Ave NW, and 3815-3841 Cathedral Ave NW, with 34 households, and its "Alley" that was inspected by DC Officials, is considered to be in poor state, and deemed to require a full reconstruction; and

Whereas the Alley was visited by the Green Alley Program Manager of Washington DC Government on April 30th, 2014, and deemed a suitable candidate to be reconstructed as a green alley, with permeable pavers, budget and other considerations allowing; and

Whereas more 90% of the households in the above mentioned City Block signed a Petition, dated May 14th, 2014, in support of a full Green Alley reconstruction, in a display of unity in support of improving the safety and environmental quality of the life of the residents in this specific City Block, and the City at large:

Therefore Be It Resolved that ANC3C fully supports the reconstruction of the alley as a Green Alley, with no further delays in the city block bordered by 3800-3828 Klinge Place NW, 3706-3718 Massachusetts Avenue NW, and 3815-3841 Cathedral Avenue NW; and

Be it Resolved that the ANC3C requests the courtesy of a response from the Green Alley Project Team regarding the following: a) the possibility of receiving a presentation about the Green Alley Project at one of the ANC3C public meetings, so that all residents may become aware of the benefits of green alleys, at the earliest convenience of the green alley team; b) a good faith estimate of when the alley mentioned in this resolution can be reconstructed as a green alley, and c) upon completion of the green alley reconstruction of The Alley, a final presentation to this ANC regarding the completion of this specific green alley project, with any findings that you may wish to share with the ANC3C at that time; and

Be It Further Resolved that the Chair or Commissioner of ANC3C07 is authorized to represent the Commission on this issue.
